We are pleased to provide you with information about the Banting Postdoctoral Fellowship 2020-21 competition, the most prestigious bursary program in Canada and the one of the highest value for postdoctoral researchers today.

The program is indeed supporting world-class postdoctoral fellows who will become the research leaders of tomorrow. The fellowship is \$ 70,000 per year, for a period of two years. The program is open to applicants who are Canadian citizens, permanent residents of Canada and foreign citizens and who obtained their PhD, PhD-equivalent or health professional degree.

The Applicants wishing to submit an application to the Banting Postdoctoral Fellowship must first submit a preliminary file and get the support of the institution. The Academic and Research Directorate of Polytechnique Montréal will then make a selection, based on the documents to be submitted by July 17, 2020 to the attention of Lucie Jean: lucie.jean@polymtl.ca.

THE PRELIMINARY FILE MUST CONTAIN:

1. **You must create a Vanier-Banting academic CCV [on the Canadian Common CV \(CCV\)](#).**
2. **Research excellence and leadership in the research domain**
 - **Description of the significance of research (max of 1 page)**

From the contributions listed in your CCV, choose up to three that you judge to be your most important research contributions and describe their significance in terms of influence on the direction of thought and activity within the target community and in terms of significance to, and use by, other researchers and knowledge users.

- **Significance of leadership contributions (max of 1 page)**
 - Description of the importance of up to three contributions in terms of leadership;
 - Supervisor's statement (Discuss the significance of the applicant's contributions of the applicant).
- 3. **Quality of applicant's proposed research program**

Title and abstract proposed research program (max of 1 page)

4. **Institutional commitment and synergy between the applicant and the institution's strategic priorities**

Provide details concerning the applicant's proposed research environment, demonstrated research capacity in the applicant's proposed field of research, which will allow the institution to provide a stimulating intellectual environment to position the candidate for success as research leaders of tomorrow (max of 1 page).
