In all professional publications, reports, presentations, conferences material and other communications, professors, researchers and clinicians who have received funding or in-kind contributions from the TransMedTech Institute must include the following acknowledgement:

"This research was conducted as part of the TransMedTech Institute's activities and thanks, in part, to funding from the Canada First Research Excellence Fund."

Highly Qualified Professionals Recruitment Program

In all professional publications, reports, presentations, conferences material and other communications, TransMedTech Institute Highly Qualified Professionals must acknowledge the contribution of the TransMedTech Institute and its main financial partner by including the following acknowledgement:

"Access to this expertise is made possible by the TransMedTech Institute and its main funding partner, the Canada First Research Excellence Fund."

Award of Excellence for Graduate Students and Postdoctoral Fellows

In all publications, reports, presentations, conferences and other professional communications, TransMedTech Institute graduate students and postdoctoral fellows must acknowledge the contribution of the TransMedTech Institute and its main financial partner by including the following acknowledgement:

"This scholarship is funded by the TransMedTech Institute and its main funding partner, the Canada First Research Excellence Fund."
